CALL FOR CONTRIBUTED PAPERS AND POSTERS

We would like to invite all those interested to submit abstracts for consideration as oral presentations at Tampa BASIS 4. This 4-day symposium will be held October 27–30, 2003 in St. Petersburg, Florida. Poster submittals are also welcome. Students are particularly encouraged to submit abstracts for either oral or poster presentation (registration fees are waived for the first author on student papers and posters). Oral presentations are limited in length to 15–20 minutes. Abstracts of all presentations will be included in the symposium program, and complete papers will be included in the Proceedings (to be issued on CD).

The overall theme of this symposium is “Linking Science and Management.” For guidance as to appropriate topics, the following are the session titles:

- 1. Fish & Wildlife**
- 2. Invasive Species**
- 3. Habitat**
- 4. Spill Prevention & Response**
- 5. Dredging & Dredged Material Management**
- 6. Water Quality/Quantity, Sediment Quality, Air Quality/Deposition**
- 7. Watershed Management**

Submittals should include: title of your presentation, author(s) and affiliation(s), contact information (e-mail and telephone number) for first or corresponding author; preferred session from list above; preference for oral or poster presentation; and an abstract not to exceed 250 words.
